

### **Bowling Green Baptist Church Nomination of Deacon Candidates** 29 April 2018

Each year in accordance with church By-Laws, we nominate, elect and ordain new Deacons. The congregation of BGBC has the privilege and responsibility to participate in this important aspect of our church by prayerfully nominating qualified men and women to serve in this position.

The New Testament provides two passages, one from the book of Acts and one from the Apostle Paul's letter to Timothy, that help us understand this important position in the life of the church. In 1 Timothy 3:8-13, we have the clearest text of scripture that describes the qualities of those who receive the role of "special servant" or "Deacon." When you look closely at this passage what you see are men and women who follow Christ closely. These are qualities that rub off on those who walk with Jesus. This is what happens to one who spends time looking at Him, listening to Him, learning from Him, and living like Him! This passage gives emphasis to what a Deacon is to be, not so much what a Deacon is to do. The inference is, if a person is what they ought to be, then they will do what they ought to do.

The passage in Acts 6:1-7, does give us a clearer glimpse as to what Deacons are to do, which is essentially this: be assistants to the Pastor and staff, be servants to the church, and be witnesses to the world!

Today, this insert has been placed in each bulletin so you can make your nominations. Additionally, the forms will be available each Sunday and in the church office through Sunday, May 20th. Please read carefully the aforementioned biblical passages to ensure the person you are nominating is scripturally gualified. Also ensure he or she is a member of the church and is currently serving or has served in some capacity in the church. 

# Musical Connections

Can you name the #1 Christian hymn on the Top 100 of all times?



If you guessed A Mighty Fortress is our God, you would be correct. It was written in 1529 by Martin Luther. Martin Luther who wrote the words once said, 'the Devil hates music because he cannot stand gaiety,' and 'Satan can smirk but he cannot laugh; he can sneer but he cannot sing.' Because he believed in the power of song, the great reformer spent a lot of time compiling a hymn book for use in congregational singing.

One writer has said that 'Luther translated the Bible into German so God could speak directly to the people; and provided the hymn so that the people could answer God in their songs.'

Luther is credited with thirty-seven hymns, by far the most popular being, "A Mighty Fortress". During those days of struggle, Luther turned often to Psalm 46 and was greatly encouraged by the words of verse one, 'God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.'

Soon a song was inspired, and Luther began in fine style with the bold declaration - 'Ein feste burg ist unswer Gott' translated: 'A sure stronghold our God is He.' It was Frederick Hedge, in his translation of 1852, who changed this to the more familiar "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God".

Luther's original composition became immediately popular with the common people of reformation Germany, being sung continually in the streets and chanted by the martyrs as they awaited their grim fate. What a moving sound that must have made! Let's carry a song in our hearts during the month of May.
